## **CLINICAL PROTOCOL\***

- Prepare canal to an appropriately-tapered shape
- Fill pulp chamber with 17% EDTA, QMix or other final rinse solution
- Select the largest Activator tip that manually fits loosely within 2 mm of working length
- Place the barrier sleeve over the handpiece and attachment
- Snap on the Activator tip over the barrier-protected attachment
- Insert the attached Activator tip into the prepared root canal
- Depress the ON/OFF switch once for 3D disinfection (18,000cpm) NOTE: Depress the ON/OFF switch twice for adjunctive procedures (3,000cpm)
- · Initiate the disinfection cycle using a crown-down method
- Continue agitating 17% EDTA for 60 SECONDS utilizing a gentle pumping motion
- Irrigate with a 6% solution of NaOCI, agitate for an additional 30 SECONDS, then use intracanal suction to eliminate loose debris
